Like milk, wine can spoil, and changes in temperature or light exposure can increase the speed of the spoilage. Wine cellars work to protect your precious bottles from the elements, and they also give you a nice place to show off your collection and store those vintage labels. This is important, since proper storage can make all the difference in the flavour and body of your wine, and might even allow it to develop into itself as it matures. At the same time, aging a bottle for too long can ruin its subtle flavours and Winecellar.co.nz know the importance of these key elements. When planning your wine cellar, whether temperature controlled or not, it is important to plan ahead and know how much space you need, even if budget and room aren't restrictions. Pick a spot away from major appliances, as heat and vibration from those units could rattle your bottles. Consider the humidity and maintain a level of 50 to 70 percent humidity in the room. Proper insulation will do this, but don't forget the door, as temperature variations can occur with the smallest bit of airflow.
